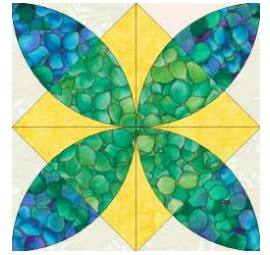

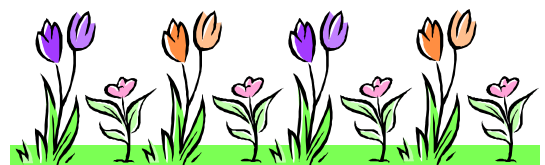


Philanthropy

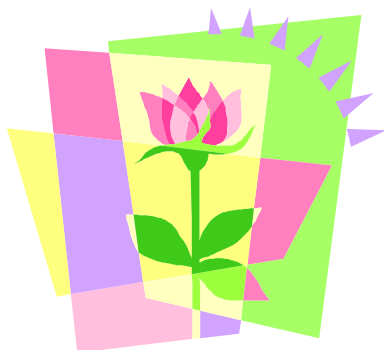
