

Block of the Month for March 2019

Here is how Block-of-the-Month works...

Complete up to five blocks. Return the completed block(s) to the Block-of-the-Month table at the designated month and, for each block you make, submit your name to the drawing held at the end of the meeting. Winner(s) takes home the blocks to use as you like.

March's Block of the Month is a "House" block. This is a 9 1/2" unfinished block. You may choose any color scheme you like. A = the sky; B = the roof; C and E = the house and D = the door. Please use a good quality 100% cotton and a scant 1/4" seam.

Construction:

1. For the sky, cut two A's 5" x 5". Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of each.
For the roof, cut one B 9 1/2" x 5".
For the house, cut one C 9 1/2" x 2"; and two E's 4" x 3 1/2".
For the door, cut one D 2 1/2" x 3 1/2"
2. With right sides together, stitch the A's to B along the diagonal line. Stitch the left side; trim seam to 1/4"; press seam towards A; and repeat with the right side.
3. Stitch C to the bottom of the roof. Press seam towards C.
4. Stitch the two E's to each side of the D along the 3 1/2" sides. Press the seams towards the E's.
5. Stitch this unit to the C. Press the seam towards C.
