

## Block of the Month for April 2019 – “H Block”

Here is how Block-of-the-Month works...

Complete up to five blocks. Return the completed block(s) to the Block-of-the-Month table at the designated month and, for each block you make, submit your name to the drawing held at the end of the meeting. Winner(s) takes home the blocks to use as you like.

Thank you to all who participated in the February Block of the Month...the paper-pieced heart. The two winners of twenty + blocks were Joy Statler and Joan McMurry. The block to be submitted at the March meeting is a “House”. See the website for complete instructions.

April’s Block is a simple “H”. Choose two fabrics: a solid for the background and a print for the “H”. Use any color combination that you wish. Please use a good quality 100% cotton and a scant  $\frac{1}{4}$ ” seam. This block will be  $9\frac{1}{2}$ ” unfinished.

**Construction:** For the “H” in the block, cut two rectangles (A) –  $3\frac{1}{2}$ ” x  $9\frac{1}{2}$ ” and one  $3\frac{1}{2}$ ” square (B).  
For the background, cut two  $3\frac{1}{2}$ ” squares (C)  
Use the diagram as a guide for positioning and then sew...  
with right sides together the two C squares to the B. Press the seams toward the B.  
Add the two A rectangles as shown to complete the “H”. Press seams toward the A’s.
