

Bullseye — Foundation Paper-Piecing Class



This eye-catching block is easier to make than it looks. Come to class and learn the techniques that make foundation paper-piecing fun!

You will work on one 20" x 20" block in class. Choose fabrics and colors for your own block to set the mood you want, either vintage or modern. You can repeat blocks to make a bigger quilt or you can use this block alone or as a center medallion. Choose fabrics and colors for your own block to set the mood you want, either vintage or modern.

A \$5 kit with instructions to make this block and printed vellum pages for 1 block and 1 sheet of self-adhesive laminate) is required.

All skill levels welcome.

Supply List for 1 Block Bullseye

There is a required \$5 kit that has the printed sheets of vellum and 1 sheet of self-adhesive laminate

and instructions to make this block.

This is a scrappy quilt and yardage amounts can vary a lot between quilters. I strongly

recommend that you work on the class block before you buy fabric for the entire quilt. That said,

yardage for the 9-block quilt is listed at the end of this supply list.

Fabric for 1 Block

If you are a fast sewer, bring fabric for 2 blocks to class. It's unlikely that you will get to a 2nd block, but

it could happen. I will have extra printed vellum on hand.

Place your pieces in separate, labeled baggies.

Center

1 - Lighter triangles: Cut 4, $2\frac{1}{4}'' \times 3\frac{1}{4}''$.

2 - Darker triangles: Cut 4, $2\frac{1}{4}'' \times 3\frac{1}{4}''$.

Ring 1

1 - Light inner triangles: Cut 16, $1\frac{3}{4}'' \times 3''$.

2 - Dark diamonds: Cut 16, $2'' \times 3\frac{3}{4}''$.

3 - Lighter outer triangles: Cut 16, $2\frac{1}{2}'' \times 2\frac{1}{2}''$.

Ring 2

1 - Light outer triangles: Cut 32, $2\frac{1}{2}'' \times 3\frac{1}{2}''$.

2 - Medium to dark outer triangles in diamond: Cut 32, $2'' \times 3\frac{1}{4}''$.

3 - Medium to dark inner triangles in diamond: Cut 32, $2'' \times 2\frac{3}{4}''$.

4 - Light inner triangles: Cut 32, 1 3/4" x 3".

Block Corners

Cut 2 rectangles 10 1/2" x 13".

Notions

- Recommended book: Bullseye Quilts from Vintage to Modern
- Rotary cutting mat
- Rotary cutter
- 3" x 12" or 6" x 12" ruler
- A sewing machine in good repair that you know how to use!
- Piecing thread
- Good fabric scissors
- Good paper scissors
- A stapler and extra staples
- Staple puller
- Pins for piecing
- Clear tape
- Seam ripper (just in case)
- An extension cord and surge protector with multiple outlets. In some venues you may not be able to (or need to) use it.
- A portable iron and mat. In some venues you may not be able to use it.
- You know what you like to have in class. It might be a chair, a cushion for the chair provided, or a light... whatever it may be, bring it with you.

Yardage for 9 Blocks

Place pieces in separate, labeled baggies.

Center

1 - Lighter triangles: $\frac{1}{3}$ yard

2 - Darker triangles: $\frac{1}{3}$ yard

Ring 1

1 - Light inner triangles: $\frac{3}{4}$ yard

2 - Dark diamonds: 1 yard

3 - Lighter outer triangles: $\frac{3}{4}$ yard

Ring 2

1 - Light outer triangles: $1\frac{7}{8}$ yards

2 - Medium to dark outer triangles in diamond: $1\frac{1}{2}$ yards

3 - Medium to dark inner triangles in diamond: $1\frac{1}{4}$ yards

4 - Light inner triangles: $1\frac{1}{4}$ yards

Block Corners

2 yards
