<u>Jean Impey – Pineapple Express</u> <u>April 14, 15 & 22, 2021</u> Sewjean.com

"Cre-a-tiv-i-ty", which builds on her previous visit with us, will be Jean's topic.
The Webinar will be Apr 14 at 10am and the link will be posted on our Facebook page, as well as an email to all Guild members.







"Pineapples have always been a symbol of Hospitality. Create a warm and inviting welcome to your home with a Pineapple Quilt by using my easy and fast organized techniques. There is no messy paper to tear-away! By using a pineapple ruler, or even a square Omni Grid ruler you will be successful in making this quilt.

This quilt can be made as large or small as you like, complicated or simple, anyway you like. Similar to a log cabin block, it starts with a central square and then grows larger by sewing strips of fabric out from the middle.

Don't want to make a whole quilt? Why not make a 20" square pillow?"

Jean will teach the Pineapple Express workshop in two sessions. The first half will be on Thursday, Apr 15. We'll meet for three hours, from 9am-12pm. For the second half of the workshop, we'll meet one week later, Thursday, Apr 22. That will also be from 9am-12pm. With a week between classes, we should make good headway on our quilt tops.

Abecedary of Quilts - Webinar May 12, 10 am

Begining at A and ending at Z, Elizabeth Eastmond takes us on a lifetime journey of quilting in her lecture Abecedary of Quilts. This is not merely an "I-can-sew-squares-and-triangles" lecture, but a rich compilation of stories, quilts, and how quilting is woven in the highs and lows of our lives. At the conclusion, she talks about how quilting is powerful and necessary.







May 13, 9 am-3:30 pm Workshop

Elizabeth will be teaching her Merrion Square quilt.

Named for a famous square in Dublin, this small quilt has tall doors on the heart-shaped row houses. While this can be made in one designer's line of fabric, it's also a Quilt that will lend itself to a scrappy look. You can take a walk around a Dublin block or make it all yours with Elizabeth's well written pattern with many illustrations. The pattern includes instructions for two different mini quilts and one larger quilt.

The \$12 downloadable pattern is required for the workshop, and you will need to order it on PayHip.com/OPquilt. There is a link on Elizabeth's website.

May 20, 10am-11am

Workshop members will meet again to show and tell their quilts. What fun to see what everyone's done! It will be a good time to share your experience creating your quilt and ask any questions you might have.

The kits contain various coordinating fabrics, which you may use as much of or as little of to create a quilt top. If there is enough fabric please make a back and cut binding strips. Feel free to use additional fabric from your stash if you wish. The quilt can be finished or just turn in a top and we will have it quilted. Batting is also available. When you turn your challenge in be sure to tell us and your name will be entered into a drawing for one of three prizes that will be given out for participation. Return By September 2021.

They are planning to have another Marine Picnic at Camp Pendleton, if all goes well, sometime in August. The exact date will be determined and we will let you know as soon as we have that date. It is always a fun day!




