Just a reminder, all mysteries are the property of the creator and can not be shared outside of the intended participants.

Current OGQG Mystery Quilt is a lap size, approximately 56" x 70". It's not too late to join—All clues will be posted on our Facebook page. I will also post a picture of my fabrics.

Fabric Requirements:

Focus fabric: This should be a medium to large scale print and CAN be a directional print if you wish.

2 yards if NOT a directional print

2 ½ yards if a directional print

Background: This can be light or dark but should be a strong contrast with your other fabrics. A solid or tone on tone mottled print will work well.

2 ¼ yards

Accent 1: Pick one of the colors from your focus fabric.

¾ yard

Accent 2: Pick a second color from your focus fabric.

1 ¼ yards

2021 School Supplies




