

You've Made Your Case Zipper Animal Cases: Turtles or Frog

#### From Karen:

As a pattern designer and illustrator for over 20 years, I specialize in animal themes with both pieced and appliquéd blocks. My quilts are unique, lively, and happy with a subtle sense of humor. I create animals with personality over realism.

Our creature cases are in a league of their own! Your workshop will focus on one case to make in class from either the Shell Shelters turtle cases or the Zippit Ribbit frog case with carry strap. (Choose one project.)

Sewing zippers, fusible foam and linings are a snap once you do them "the right way," and we'll cover alternate methods for feet and eyes, as well different stuffing and turning techniques.

Attach an optional shoulder strap and they can carry thread collections, sewing tools or be used as a child's pajama bag. These make wonderful gifts or great donations for your guild's next fundraiser. Pattern included in workshop.


